What should I bring?

Yes! In case of inclement weather, the event will be held in the wedding tent. **We will send an email to all RSVPs Sunday morning if the event location has moved.**

What time does it start?

Gates open at 5:00 PM for picnicking. Music to follow shortly.

Will there be food?

Yes, **there will be food available for purchase!** Woodbelly Pizza, Sisters of Anarchy Ice Cream, and Trapp's Bierhall will be on site selling slices, scoops, brats, and pretzels.

Payment options include cash or card. **If you prefer not to wait in line, we recommend bringing a picnic,** but please do not bring your own alcohol.

How about drinks?

von Trapp Brewing will have wine, Stowe Cider and Austrian-style lagers for purchase. Woodbelly will offer non-alcoholic beverages for purchase and there will be water stations.

Outside alcoholic drinks are not permitted; however non-alcoholic beverages are welcome.
